Yes, for travel to A and CH, you will need to purchase the toll stickers.

The stickers are available at gas stations near the border.

In 2005 the fees were as follows:

Swiss Highway - 40 Swiss francs (US\$35)

Austrian passenger-car vignette - Prices range from 7.60 euros (\$10) for a 10-day sticker to 72.60 euros (\$93) for a year (14 months). You can buy an Austrian or Swiss vignette at gas stations, at border crossings, or at post offices.
